

ADIDAS ORIGINALS YEEZY BOOST 350

One of the most anticipated sneakers to hit shelves this summer is undoubtedly the adidas Yeezy Boost 350. Having first debuted in New York at the YEEZY Season 1 presentation show this year, 'Ye fans and sneakerheads have been fighting to get their hands on the latest design from the enigmatic musician-turned-designer. The Yeezy Boost 350 features moccasin construction, premium suede arch support in combination with the highly touted Boost sole.

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ADIDAS ULTRA BOOST

The adidas Ultra Boost - the company's most renowned running shoe of 2015 - has seen a number of new makeovers since its inception, including collaborations with five leading design mavericks: Stella McCartney, Kris Van Assche, kolor's Junichi Abe, and adidas Creative Directors Dirk Schönberger and James Carnes. The shoe embodies the innovative tradition of adidas with BOOST technology, devised to deliver an unparalleled running experience.



NIKE AIR MAX ZERO

This year's annual Air Max Day celebrated the history of visible air by offering up a brand new model, arriving as the Nike Air Max Zero - a model that was inspired from one of the initial sketches created by Tinker Hatfield. Perfectly blending retro aesthetics with modern technology, the shoe initially dropped in limited numbers making it a very special silhouette.



BAPE X UNDFTD X ADIDAS ORIGINALS SUPERSTAR 80S

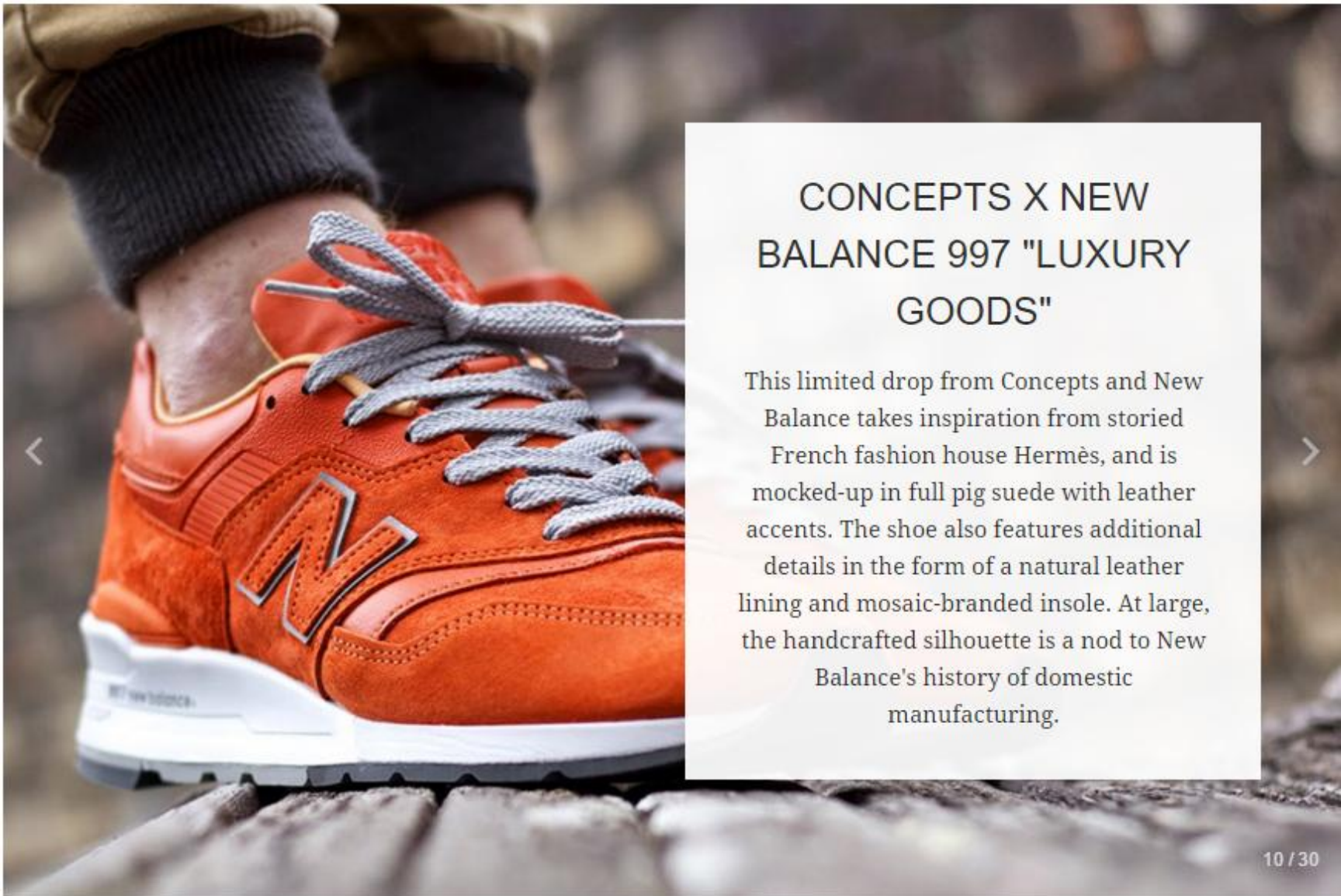
Not the first time that BAPE, UNDFTD and the Three Stripes have come together - but still a banger - 2015 saw several new takes on the Superstar. The classic kicks saw the use of BAPE and UNDFTD's respective insignia, further characterized by the inclusion of a leather upper and the hallmark shell toe with matching camo accents appearing on the tongue and heel of the sneakers.





CLOT X NIKE LUNAR FORCE 1

After delays on delays, CLOT finally dropped its long-awaited Nike Lunar Force 1 this spring. The ultra-clean iteration saw the use of bite-sized, jeweled Swooshes in red and blue, paired with a gum sole and Hyperfuse panels along the upper. Vintage varsity jacket designs served as the principal inspiration for the sneaker.



CONCEPTS X NEW BALANCE 997 "LUXURY GOODS"

This limited drop from Concepts and New Balance takes inspiration from storied French fashion house Hermès, and is mocked-up in full pig suede with leather accents. The shoe also features additional details in the form of a natural leather lining and mosaic-branded insole. At large, the handcrafted silhouette is a nod to New Balance's history of domestic manufacturing.
